Paradigm Shift from Materialism to a Process-Relational Philosophy

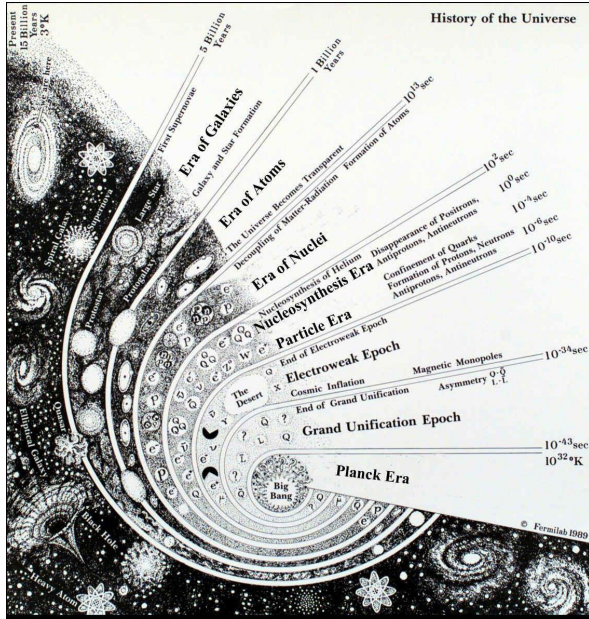

Astrology is being haunted.



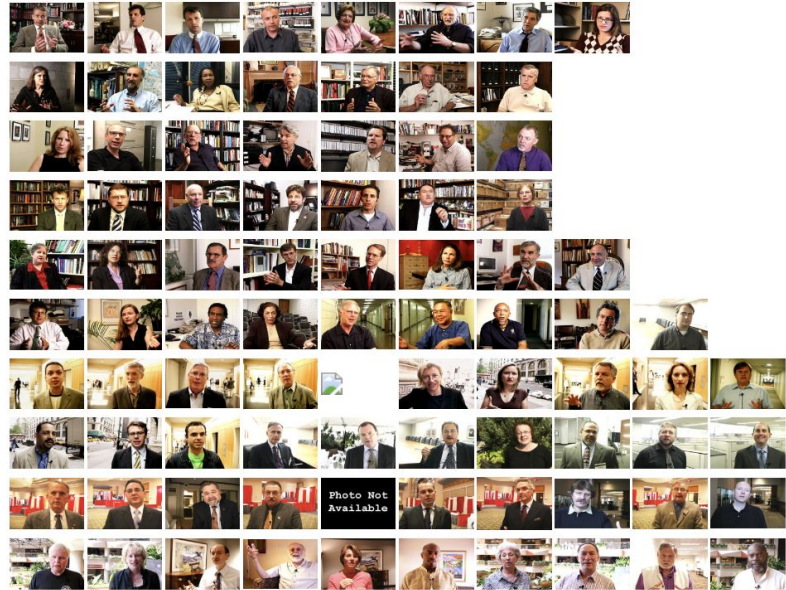

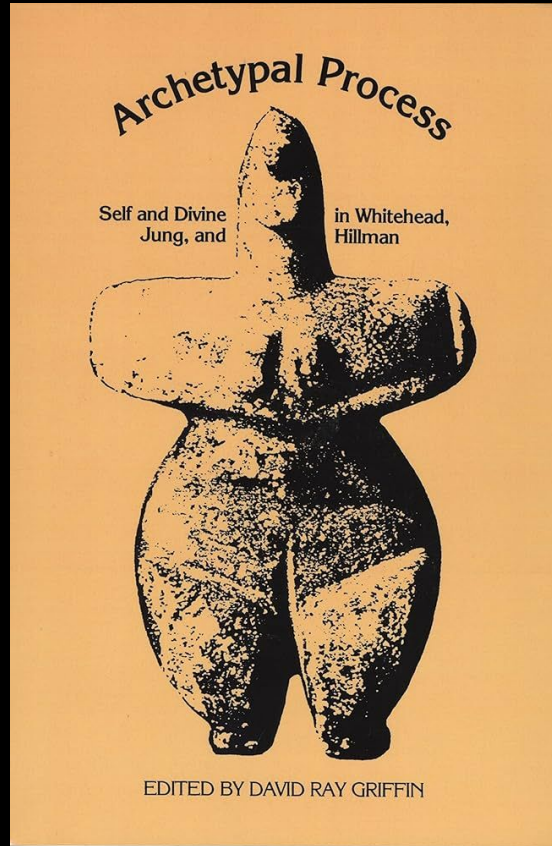
“I believe that a more plausible and comprehensive explanation of the available evidence would rest on a conception of the universe as a fundamentally and irreducibly interconnected whole, informed by creative intelligence and pervaded by patterns of meaning and order that extend through every level, and that are expressed through a constant correspondence between astronomical events and human events. Such a view is concisely reflected in the Hermetic axiom “as above, so below,” which describes a universe all of whose parts and dimensions are integrated into an intelligible whole. In the perspective I am suggesting here, reflecting the dominant trend in contemporary astrological theory, the planets do not “cause” specific events any more than the hands on a clock “cause” a specific time. Rather, the planetary positions are indicative of the cosmic state of archetypal dynamics at that time.”

Abstract: It is argued that quantum theory is best understood as requiring an ontological dualism of *res extensa* and *res potentia*, where the latter is understood per Heisenberg's original proposal, and the former is roughly equivalent to Descartes' 'extended substance.' However, this is not a dualism of mutually exclusive substances in the classical Cartesian sense, and therefore does not inherit the infamous 'mind-body' problem. Rather, *res potentia* and *res extensa* are understood as mutually implicative ontological extants that serve to explain the key conceptual challenges of quantum theory;

Primas Says We Need New Non-Boolean Frameworks for Time

BASIC PRESUPPOSITIONS

MAIN THESIS:

A full understanding of time is not possible within a framework governed by Boolean Logic.

The description of matter requires a non-Boolean theory, so that a description of a universe of discourse which encompasses wider domains also require a non-Boolean theory.

In the following, I will discuss this universe of discourse using the mathematical tools of quantum mechanics but I will not use any physical concepts of the theory of matter.

THE UNIVERSE AS A TRIPARTITE SYSTEM

The universe of discourse will be described as a tripartite system, represented by a W^* -tensor product

$$\mathfrak{A} = \mathfrak{M} \bar{\otimes} \mathfrak{T} \bar{\otimes} \mathfrak{N}$$

- The W^* -algebra \mathfrak{M} refers to a non-intentional *atemporal material domain*.
- The W^* -algebra \mathfrak{N} refers to a *atemporal mental domain*.
- The W^* -algebra \mathfrak{T} refers to a *temporal domain*.

BORROMEAN CORRELATIONS

To the best of our present knowledge there are no interactions

- between the *material* and the *temporal* domain,
- between the *temporal* and the *mental* domain,
- between the *mental* and the *material* domain.

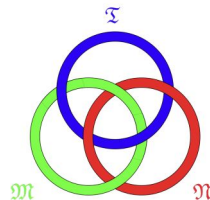
Nevertheless the systems \mathfrak{M} , \mathfrak{T} and \mathfrak{N} are as a rule *entangled*.

If these correlations are *Borromean*, then no two systems are directly entangled, but the three systems are *only triply correlated*. In this case the *matter–mind*-system, the *mind–time*-system, and the *time–matter*-system are trivial.

BORROMEAN RINGS

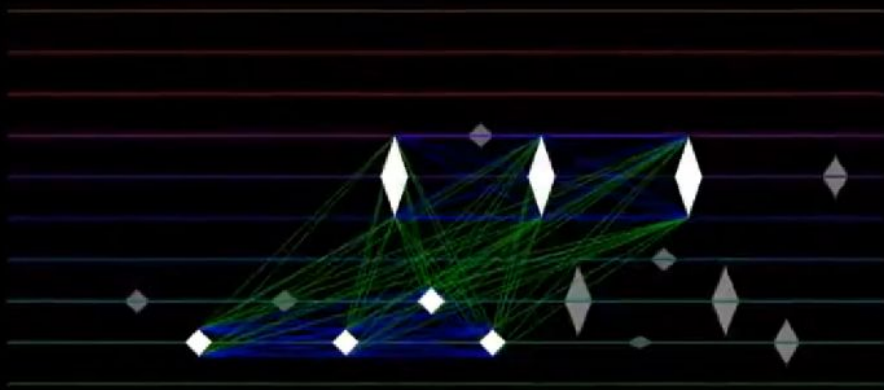
In a Borromean knot three rings are knotted together in such a way that if any one of the rings are cut, the other two fall away.

A Borromean system is pairwise uncorrelated but triply correlated. It has a much richer structure than the three underlying domains.

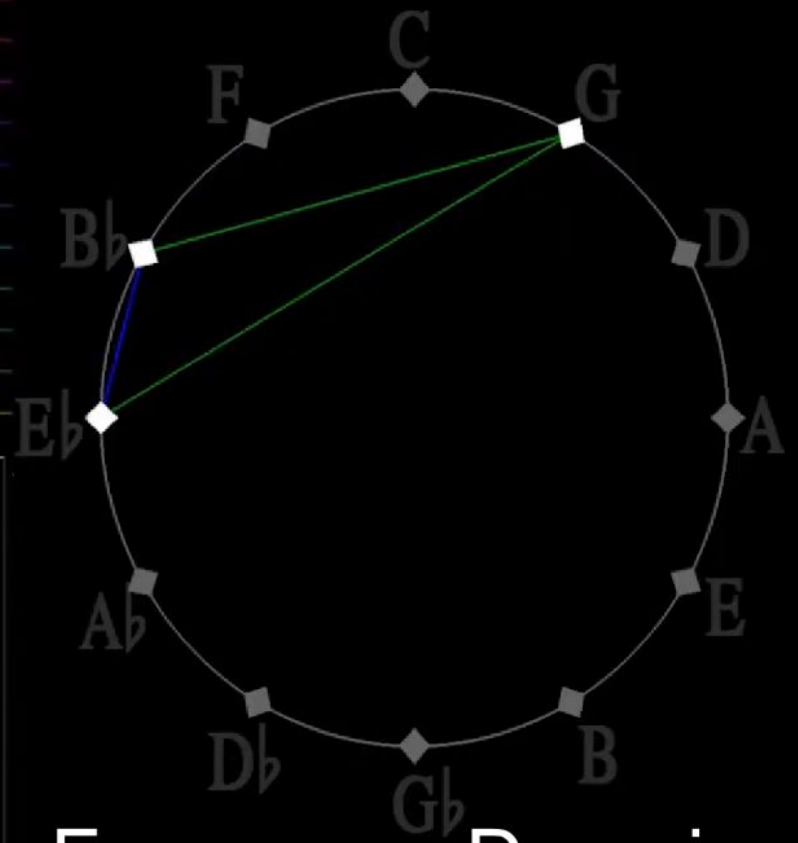

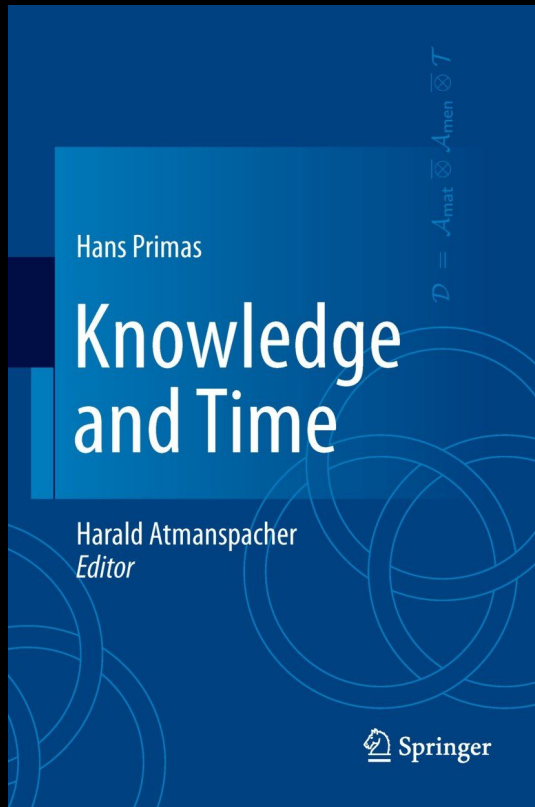

Primas: Music is an Exemplification of Time with Rhythm, Pitch, Octaves, Tempo, Amplitude, Loudness, Melody, Repetition



In particular, the following *approximate* invariances play a crucial role for the recognition of musical patterns. They refer to the following groups:

- *Time-translation group isomorphic to $(\mathbb{R}, +)$* : It is inessential whether a piece of music is played earlier or later. That is, the relevant information contained in it is independent of the choice of the time origin, and parts of a musical piece can be combined by addition.
- *Logfrequency-translation group isomorphic to \mathbb{R}^+* : Human pitch perception is roughly logarithmic with respect to frequency. That is, a note doubled in frequency sounds similar to the original (music perception is octave-cycle invariant). Western musical tradition subdivides the octave into 12 (logarithmically) equally spaced pitch classes, known as the well-tempered scale. Therefore, it makes sense to express acoustic frequencies on a logfrequency axis.
- *Time multiplicative scaling group isomorphic to $(\mathbb{R}^+ \setminus \{0\}, \times)$* : In spite of the fact that most tunes have a preferred tempo, we can recognize a piece of music irrespective of its playback speed. This approximate invariance under *time scaling* plays a crucial role for the recognition of musical patterns.
- *Amplitude scaling group \mathcal{D}* : Playing music more quietly or more loudly does not change the musical quality of a tune. Music remains the same no matter at what volume it is played.
- *Loudness scaling group \mathcal{D}* : Perception of sound intensity is approximately logarithmic.
- *Self-similarity*: On the self-similarity of musical processes compare Sect. 10.2.7.

Invariance under scale transformations plays a crucial role for the recognition of patterns in general.

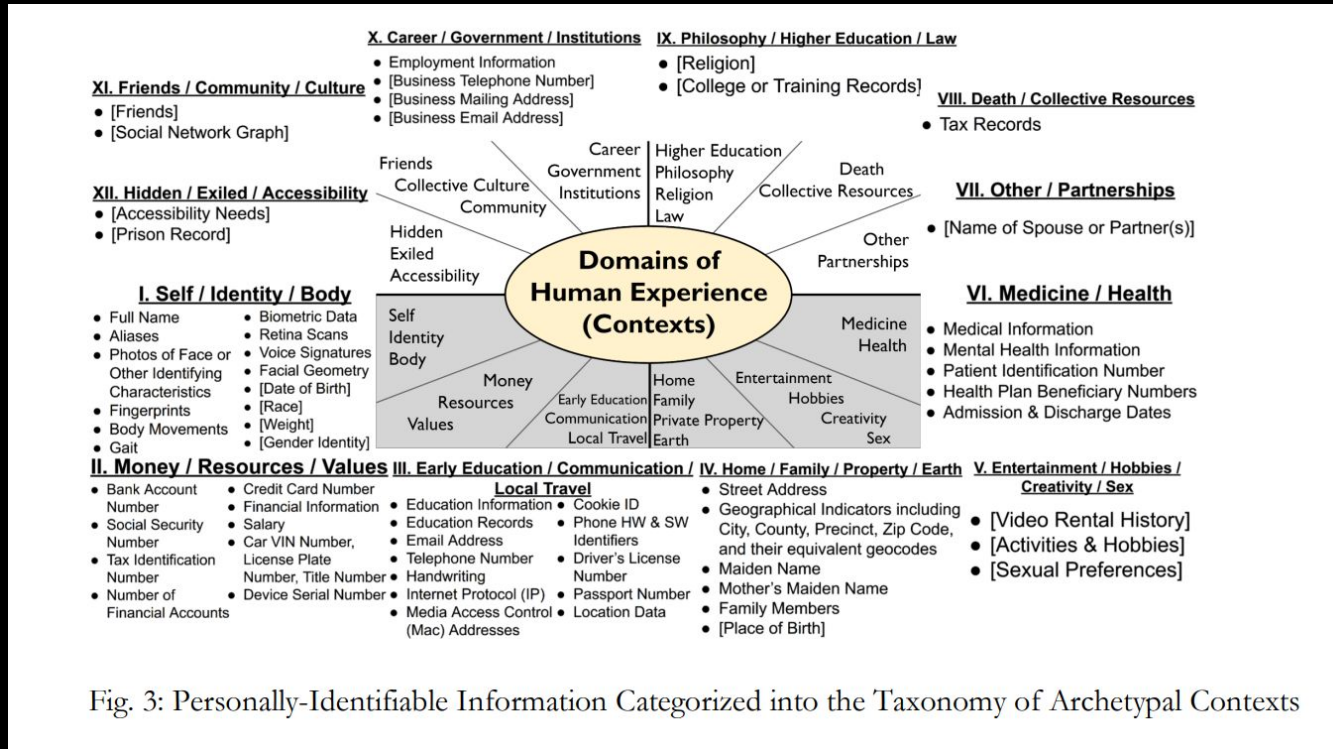


Fig. 3: Personally-Identifiable Information Categorized into the Taxonomy of Archetypal Contexts

In this paper, I address the question as to why participants tend to respond realistically to situations and events portrayed within an immersive virtual reality system. The idea is put forward, based on the experience of a large number of experimental studies, that there are two orthogonal components that contribute to this realistic response. The first is 'being there', often called 'presence', the qualia of having a sensation of being in a real place. We call this place illusion (PI). Second, plausibility illusion (Psi) refers to the illusion that the scenario being depicted is actually occurring. In the case of both PI and Psi the participant knows for sure that they are not 'there' and that the events are not occurring. PI is constrained by the sensorimotor contingencies afforded by the virtual reality system. Psi is determined by the extent to which the system can produce events that directly relate to the participant, the overall credibility of the scenario being depicted in comparison with expectations. We argue that when both PI and Psi occur, participants will respond realistically to the virtual reality.





Dustin Chertoff has pulled experiential design insights from the advertising world to come up with a more holistic theory of presence in virtual reality. In 2008, he was in graduate school and was dissatisfied with the major theories of VR presence. His gaming experience showed him how much of his feeling of immersion was related to the content of the game. He wrote an essay published in the journal *Presence* where he laid out what he saw were the two major limitations of VR presence theory at that time, "First, many models tend to focus heavily on perceptual issues while focusing less attention other facets of virtual experiences, such as cognition and emotion." Second, "these models fail to provide an interpretable, extensible framework with which to understand and apply the theoretical principles to practical applications."

Improving Presence Theory Through Experiential Design

Abstract

Despite ongoing research over the last 15 years, the presence construct remains somewhat limited in its ability to be applied beyond the sensory domain. In order to increase its usefulness for applied challenges (e.g., using presence theory to enhance simulators' effectiveness), a discussion about a new conceptualization of presence is introduced. This novel perspective on presence is rooted in the notion of "experiential design," an approach businesses use to create strategically compelling and memorable experiences. The paper begins with a brief review of presence and then a description of the concepts of experimental design. Following this, a theoretical model of presence, based upon experimental design, is offered. Using this model, an exploration on the mitigation of breaks in presence is offered (a break in presence occurs when presence fails to be maintained). These ideas are presented in order to improve the likelihood of presence emerging for simulation participants and to enhance interdisciplinary researchers' shared conceptualizations of presence.

In this article, I contrast traditional marketing with a new approach to marketing called Experiential Marketing and provide a strategic framework for Experiential Marketing. Traditional marketing views consumers as rational decision-makers who care about functional features and benefits. In contrast, experiential marketers view consumers as rational and emotional human beings who are concerned with achieving pleasurable experiences. Five different types of experiences, or strategic experiential modules (SEMs), that marketers can create for customers are distinguished: sensory experiences (SENSE); affective experiences (FEEL); creative cognitive experiences (THINK); physical experiences, behaviours and lifestyles (ACT); and social-identity experiences that result from relating to a reference group or culture (RELATE). These experiences are implemented through so-called experience providers (ExPros) such as communications, visual and verbal identity, product presence, electronic media, etc. The ultimate goal of experiential marketing is to create holistic experiences that integrate individual experiences into a holistic Gestalt. The paper concludes with an examination of strategic issues and a discussion about how to create the experience-oriented organization.

Brand Experience: What Is It? How Is It Measured? Does It Affect Loyalty?

Brand experience is conceptualized as sensations, feelings, cognitions, and behavioral responses evoked by brand-related stimuli that are part of a brand's design and identity, packaging, communications, and environments. The authors distinguish several experience dimensions and construct a brand experience scale that includes four dimensions: sensory, affective, intellectual, and behavioral. In six studies, the authors show that the scale is reliable, valid, and distinct from other brand measures, including brand evaluations, brand involvement, brand attachment, customer delight, and brand personality. Moreover, brand experience affects consumer satisfaction and loyalty directly and indirectly through brand personality associations.

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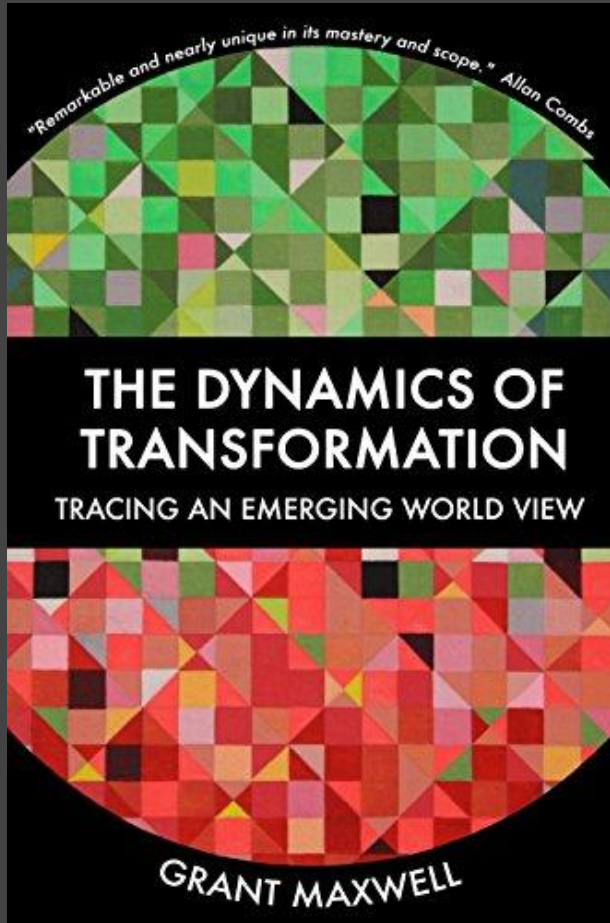
“Process Philosophy”

“Process philosophy is based on the premise that being is dynamic and that the dynamic nature of being should be the primary focus of any comprehensive philosophical account of reality and our place within it. Even though we experience our world and ourselves as continuously changing, Western metaphysics has long been obsessed with describing reality as an assembly of static individuals whose dynamic features are either taken to be mere appearances or ontologically secondary and derivative.”

Whitehead's Descriptive Process-Relational Metaphysical Framework

“The basic unit of reality in Whitehead’s system is an event-like entity called “actual occasion,” which is the procedural integration or “concrecence” of processes of data transfer (“prehensions”) into unities that become new data. Each actual occasion is the growing together of the total available information of the universe at that time, according to certain principles, repeating and reinforcing certain patterns (“eternal objects”) and thereby creating new ones. Whitehead’s process metaphysics is arguably the most comprehensive descriptive metaphysical framework we have to date.”

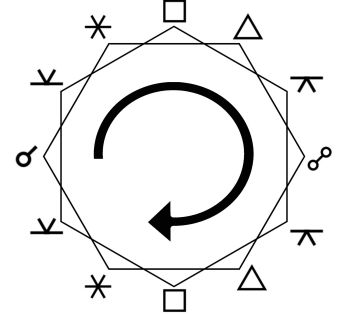
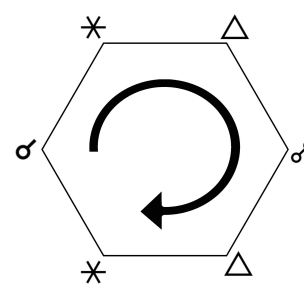
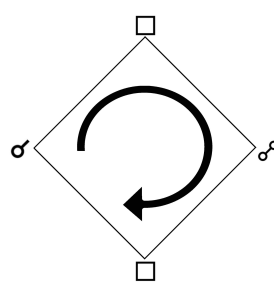
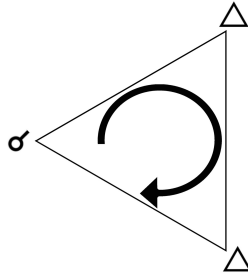
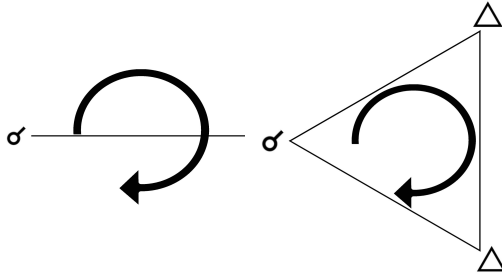
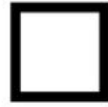
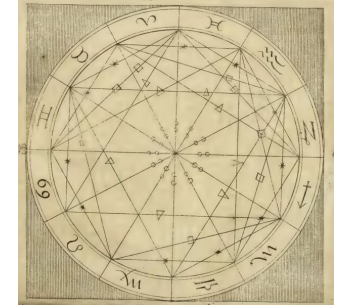
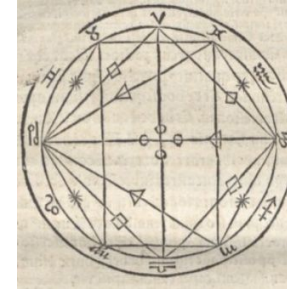
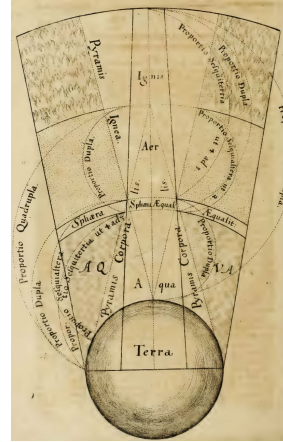
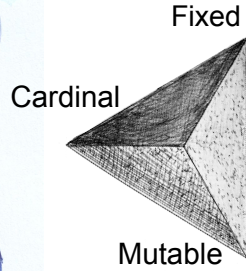
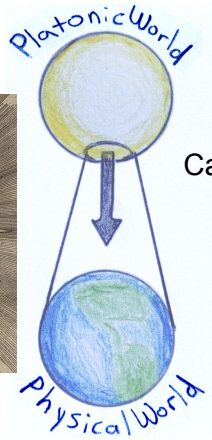
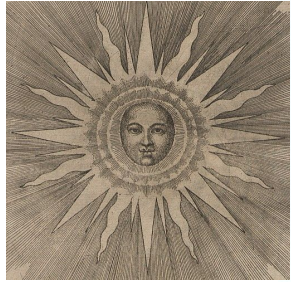
Perception-Decision-Action Loop (2006)

Chapter 8

Beyond Hermeneutics: Peirce's Semiology as a Trinitarian Metaphysics of Communication

The semiology of Charles Sanders Peirce, the founder of pragmatism, is a standing challenge as much to Gadamerian hermeneutics as to Saussure's structuralism and its deconstructionist progeny. Peirce's semiology constitutes a rejection of Saussure: because Saussure's structuralism operates only in terms of a binary or dyadic relation of signifier (words) and signified (concepts), his account of communication is nominalist (concepts say nothing about the world) and subjective-idealist (communication is a matter of linguistic structures alone). Deconstruction takes this subjective idealism to its extreme limit by treating communication as nothing more than the differential plurality of signifiers – a paradoxical form of monism. Peirce's semiology equally rejects the hermeneutical restriction of communication to human interaction with the world; even if Gadamer occasionally hints at a larger metaphysics,¹ he is unable to realise it on account of his subjective-idealist entanglements. Now Peirce is indeed an idealist, but his is an ontological or objective idealism in the sense that he sees the cosmos as an information exchange system, a communication system that is constituted by the interpretation of signs.² For Peirce, physical matter itself is

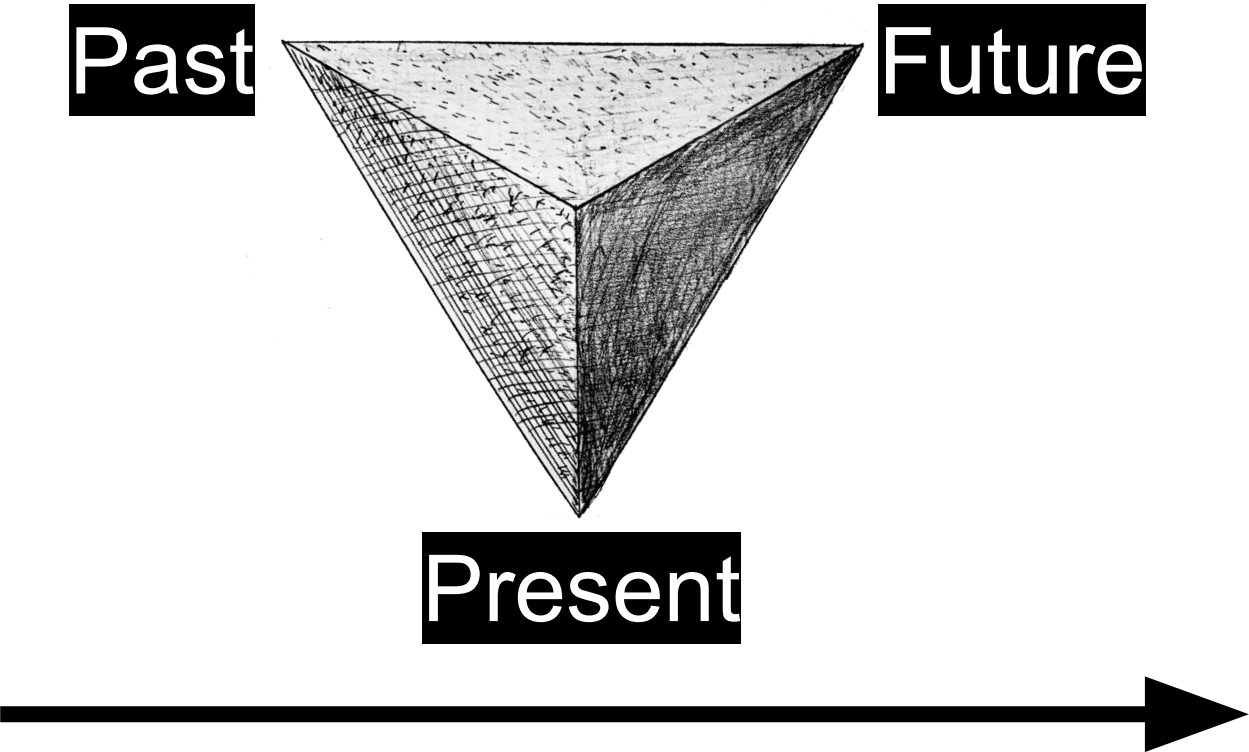

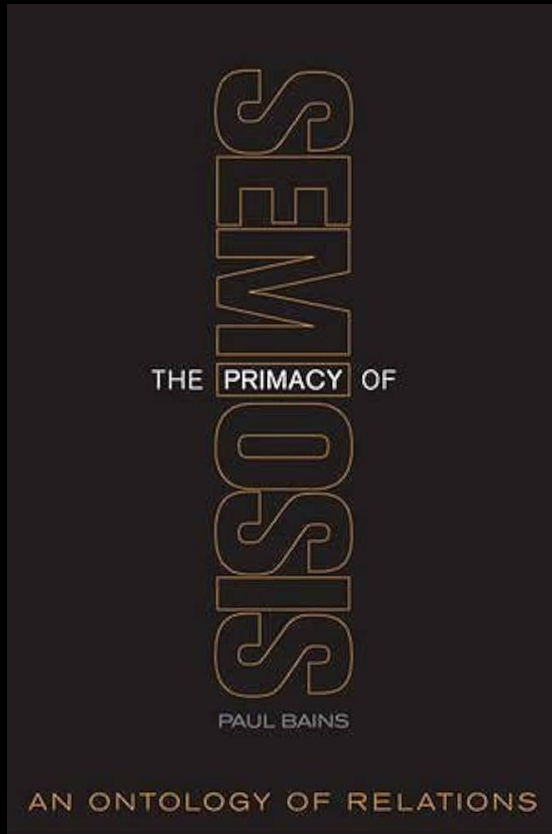

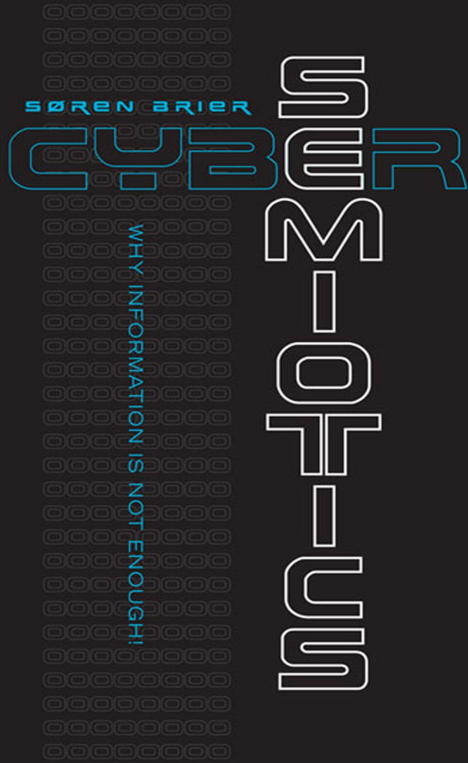

Abstract: Conceptual dualities (wave-particle, mind-matter, one-many, abstract-concrete, etc.) are rather ubiquitous in philosophical and scientific thinking, but are they ever properly, metaphysically fundamental? Based on a remarkable confluence of developments in logic, mathematics, and physics, we argue that dyads always occur within a context that points to a triad. This indicates that dyads are not metaphysically fundamental even though they provide very useful approximations for various practical purposes and applications. Charles Sanders Peirce's and Charles Hartshorne's insights into the logic of relations express and underpin what we view as the correct understanding that temporal process is objectively real and that symmetry within an all-embracing and contextualized asymmetry is an ultimate conceptual pattern capable of properly metaphysical generalization. We emphasize that what is seldom recognized is the coherent consilience of such philosophical and scientific developments into the triadic generalization.

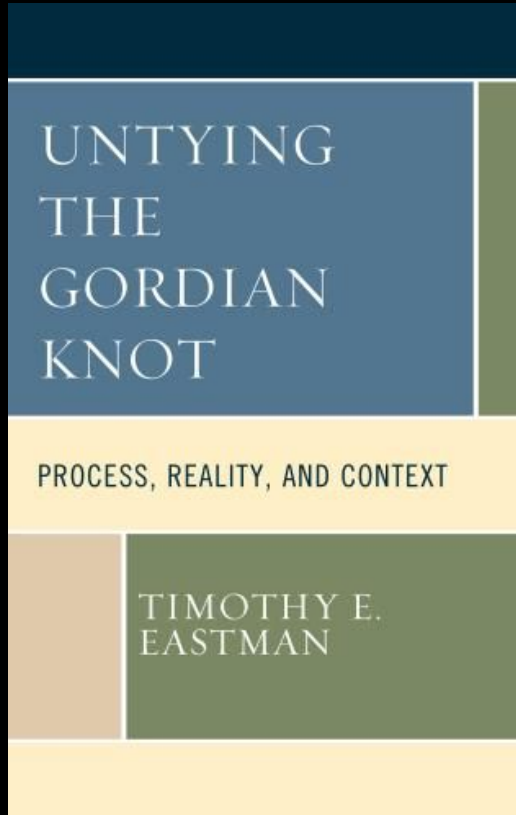

“In Peirce’s triadic philosophy, feelings, qualia, habit formation, and signification are basic ontological constituents of reality. This suggests that the semiotic paradigm should be able to penetrate beyond chemistry and physics to “the bottom of nature.” This amounts to a clash with basic beliefs in sizable parts of information science, which seems to want to construct meaning as a bottom-up procedure from a thermodynamically based information science.”

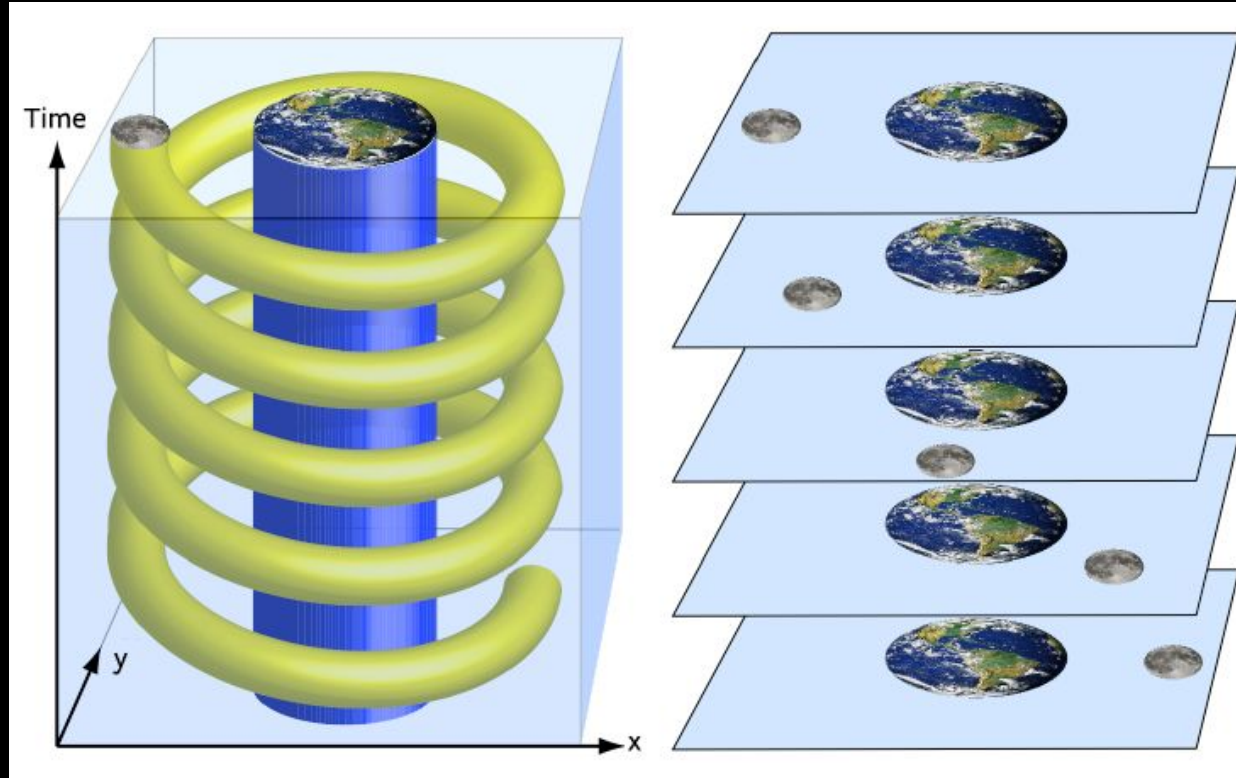

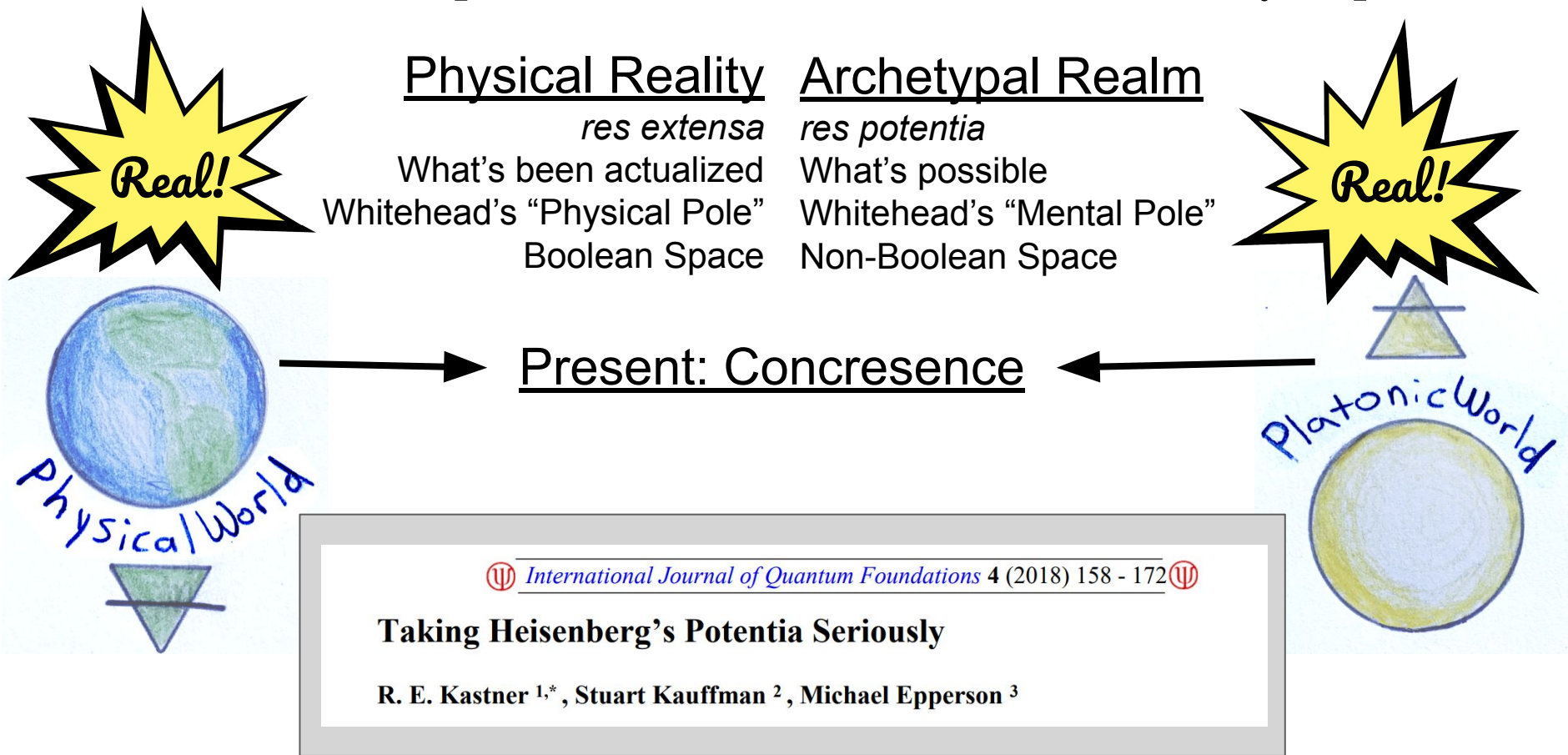


“The central thesis of the Relational Reality model is that the classical, conventional conception of the relationship between physical objects and their presumed direct mapping to discrete facts must be reconceived such that physical things are understood as the outcome of real histories of quantum events.

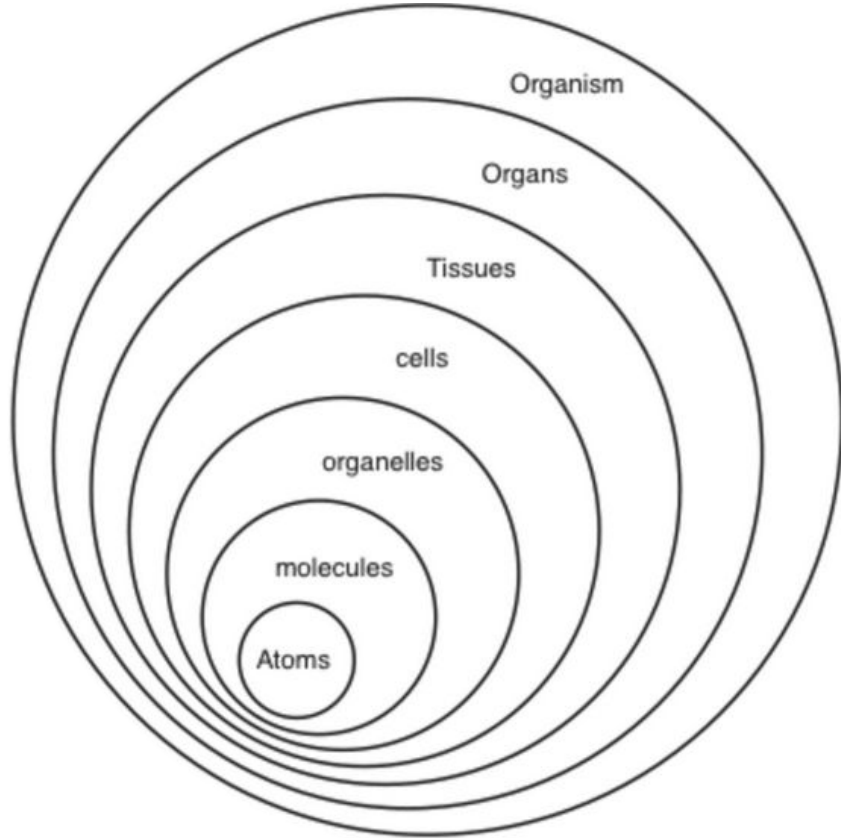
This requires a reconceptualization of ontological and contextual properties as mutually implicative features of every quantum event (thus, inevitably, the triad of input-output-context). In this Relational Realist framework, quantum events are identified as measurement outcomes that refer to corresponding physical observables. The theory then provides the means of relating these events.”

Empedocles' Cosmic Cycle Between Love, Strife, & Sphairos

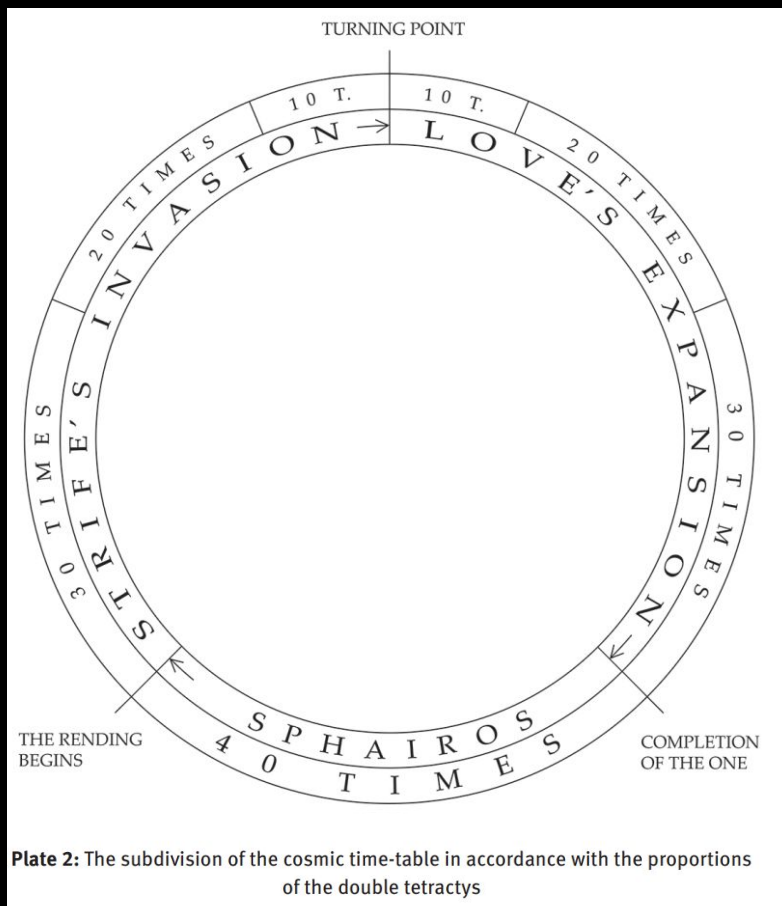


Plate 2: The subdivision of the cosmic time-table in accordance with the proportions of the double tetractys

“According to Empedocles, it is impossible to provide a satisfactory account of all states and events in the history of the universe by assuming a *globally stable* interaction of the six principles. The world’s course is determined, rather, by a regular alternation between a period of increasing Love, which leads towards *total mixture* of the four elements, and a period of increasing Strife, which leads towards *total separation* of the four elements... The process of mixture brought about by Love’s expansion leads to a state of rest in which the four elements are completely mixed and combined into a spherical god, the Sphairos;”

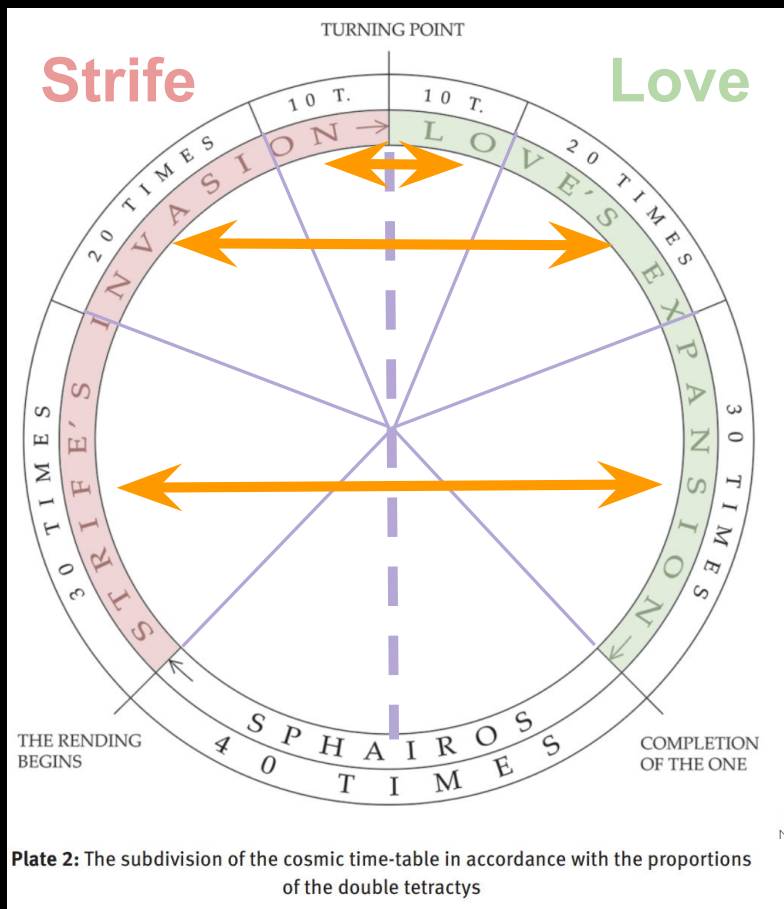
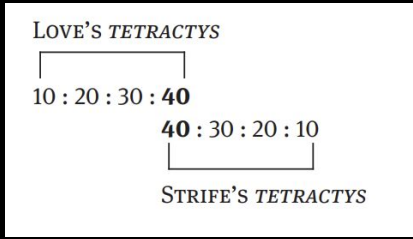


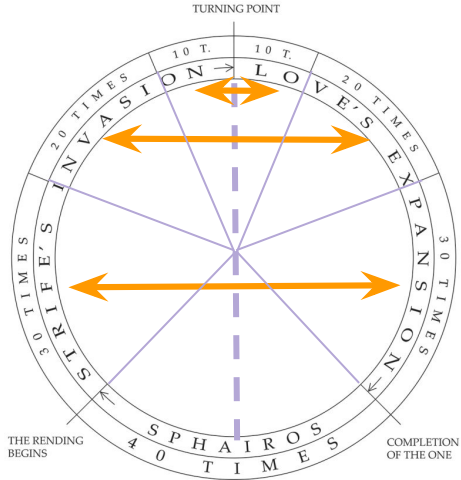
Plate 2: The subdivision of the cosmic time-table in accordance with the proportions of the double tetractys

“According to Empedocles, it is impossible to provide a satisfactory account of all states and events in the history of the universe by assuming a *globally stable* interaction of the six principles. The world’s course is determined, rather, by a regular alternation between a period of increasing Love, which leads towards *total mixture* of the four elements, and a period of increasing Strife, which leads towards *total separation* of the four elements... The process of mixture brought about by Love’s expansion leads to a state of rest in which the four elements are completely mixed and combined into a spherical god, the Sphairos;”

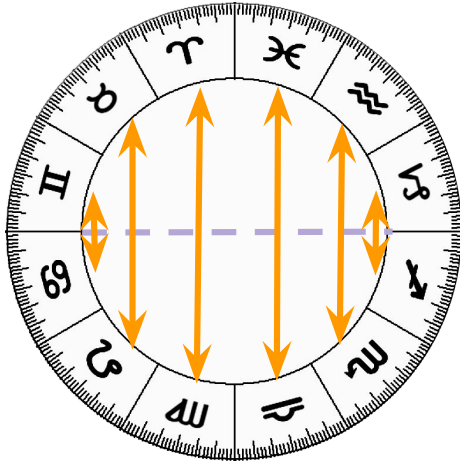

Chronos Time vs Kairos Time (Sequential Time vs Non-Sequential Time)



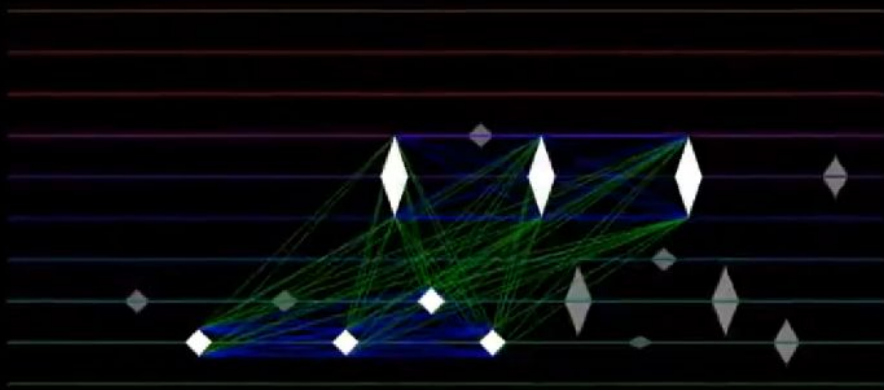
1.4.1 Chronos and Kairos

The ancient Greeks divided the notion of time into two complementary manifestations: *κρονος* (kronos) and *καιρος* (kairos).³ In Greek mythology, *Kronos* was the son of Gaia and Uranus and was overthrown by his son Zeus and imprisoned in Tartarus. *Kairos*, the youngest son of Zeus, was the personification of opportunity, luck and favorable moments.

In *Physics* (Book IV, Chap. 11, 219b), Aristotle (1983) defined *chronos*⁴ as the “number of changes with respect to the before and the after”, which is an expression of sequential time: the future passing through the present and so becoming the past. Chronos time, therefore, is neither an independent substance nor identical with motion. It is composed of a past that is gone, a present that exists, and a future that has to come yet. Chronos time is quantitative and can be measured with clocks. It relates to sequential logic and analytic thinking.

Kairos time is qualitative and denotes the sense of doing the right thing at the right time.⁵ Kairos time refers to a realm outside of measurable clock time. Kairos time is meaningful and pregnant with possibility, opportunity, and wisdom. In the pedagogical tradition Kairos refers to the crucial moment of transformative insight and encompasses the occasion itself. For Friedrich Copei (1950, p. 17, editor’s translation) Kairos refers to

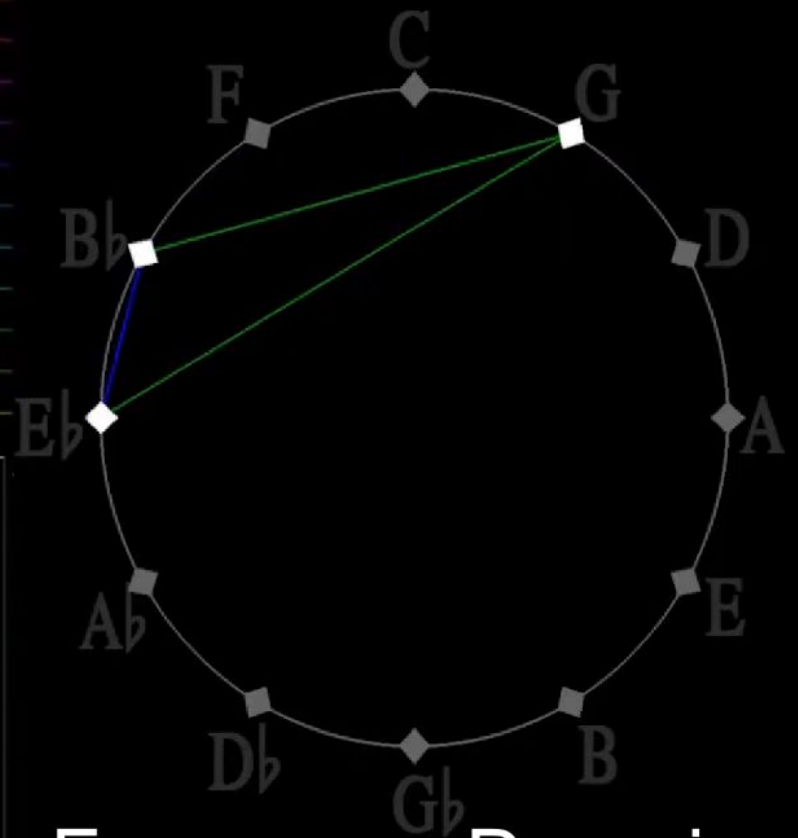
the “fruitful moments” in an educational process—those peculiar moments in which a new insight awakens in us in a flash, an idea seizes us, and we suddenly see a situation in an entirely new light.
